

**Minutes of the meeting of the Screening Committee held on 17-11-2008 in the chamber of Joint Secretary (SD) to discuss the new proposals received under Integrated Programme for Older Persons.**

The meeting of the Screening Committee for consideration of new proposals received under the Integrated Programme for Older Persons was held on 17-11-2008 at 11.00 a.m. at Shastri Bhawan under the Chairmanship of Dr.Arbind Prasad, Joint Secretary(SD) in the Ministry. Sh.M.M.Sabharwal, President Emeritus, Helpage India, who is a member of the Committee, also attended the meeting.

2. At the outset, the Committee was informed that the revised scheme of Integrated Programme for Older Persons had been operationalised w.e.f. 1-4-2008. Besides introducing new activities for the welfare of older persons, the financial outlay for the existing projects had also been enhanced considerably. The Committee reviewed the expenditure position till now and expressed their concern over low utilization of budget so far. The Committee was informed that the Ministry had written to the State Governments at regular intervals to send the continuing/new proposals timely, but they had started sending the same only from mid-August.

3. It was also observed by the Committee that though in some States, the notional allocation was being fully utilized, yet many Districts in these States may also be unserved or underserved. So, in the wake of savings in budget allocation for the scheme, new projects in such cases can still be considered. Further, in view of revised scheme, innovative projects like physiotherapy centres, helplines etc. proposed even in served districts may also be considered to provide new services for older persons in these areas. It was further observed that in order to ensure presence of projects in unserved areas, the Ministry could take the help of reputed NGOs such as Helpage India, Dignity Foundation, Anugraha etc. in sensitizing good organizations working in those areas to come forward in establishing services for the elderly.

4. Most of the projects in the unserved areas or the innovative projects like widows' homes, physiotherapy centres etc. were proposed projects. It was deliberated that unless some exception was made, it was difficult to ensure establishment of innovative projects or the presence of projects in unserved areas. It was, therefore, decided by the Committee to consider such proposals, if the concerned organization had been associated with the activities pertaining to welfare of older persons for at least two years.

5. The Committee were informed that all the new proposals ( total: 214 cases) received from the State Governments till 15-10-2008 had been included in the lists presented to the Committee. The new cases ( total 214 cases ) have been received from Assam(45), Karnataka(12), Madhya Pradesh(12). Maharashtra(10) Manipur(29), Nagaland(8), Orissa(50), Rajasthan(30), Tamil Nadu( 4), Uttarakhand(4), and West Bengal(10), After considering the notional allocation, utilization so far, number of ongoing projects, availability of necessary documents, previous experience in the field and the nature of the project ( i.e. whether innovative or otherwise), the Committee recommended a total number of ( 134 )new cases under the scheme **Integrated Programme for Older Persons** as per details given below:-

6. The committee noticed that some of the proposals placed for consideration were already recommended in its previous meetings on 19.6.2007, 19.11.2007 & 14.2.2008, but grants were not released and few proposals were for previous year 2007-08. In this connection, committee was informed that as per the policy decision contained in the

Ministry's Office Order No.1-31/2006-Cdn, dated 5.9.2008, recommendations of the State GIA committee for new projects would remain valid for the financial year following the year in which they were received and recommendation of Screening Committee within the Ministry would be valid for one year. The Committee, therefore, decided to recommend those proposals which were already recommended in its earlier meetings on 19.6.2007, 19.11.2007 & 14.2.2008, and recommended again by the State Government.

7. State wise position of proposals placed before the committee and those which were recommended by the committee for setting up various projects subject to other conditions and completion of necessary formalities as per the norms of the scheme and relevant guide lines is as follows:-

**Recommendation:** The committee noticed that there are more than one proposals for the same district and 21 proposals at Sl.No. 1 to 21 were already recommended by the Committee. The Committee observed that this state was already utilizing funds more than its notional allocation. So, it was decided to renew 21 cases, which were approved during 2007-08 and also 4 innovative projects, subject to fulfillment of all the conditions. The rest of the proposals may be considered next time depending upon fund position at that time. Hence the committee recommended following 25 proposals including the 21 proposals recommended earlier subject to completion of deficient documents (if any) and other conditions and completion of necessary formalities as per the norms of the scheme and relevant guide lines as given below :-

**Recommendation:** Considering the existing utilization of funds in the Maharashtra State vis-à-vis its notional allocation, and the number of ongoing projects in the State, the committee decided to recommend all the above proposals subject to completion of deficient documents (if any) and other conditions and completion of necessary formalities as per the norms of the scheme. The Committee further observed that the State Government had recommended only a few projects, and that too were restricted to 3 districts. The Committee, therefore, observed that the Ministry may take up the issue with the State Government to ensure equitable distribution of projects.

**Recommendation:** The Committee observed that though Orissa was already utilizing funds more than its notional allocation and most of its districts were already served, more than half of the new proposals were innovative projects. It was accordingly decided to sanction innovative projects subject to fulfillment of other terms and conditions. However, it was decided that out of a large number of innovative projects proposed by Nilanchal Seva Sansthan, Puri, presently only one project of each type may be approved with the condition that all these projects would be located in the existing campus at Puri.
